The **10th International Conference on B-Physics at Hadron Machines - BEAUTY 2005** will be held from **June 20 to 24, 2005** at the **Cittadella** in **Assisi** (Perugia) in **Umbria**, Italy.

The purpose of this conference is to review results in the field of B-physics, CP violation and to explore the physics potential and experimental reach of current and future generations of B-physics experiments at hadron machines. The first conference was held at Liblice Castle, Czech Republic in 1993, the last one at Pittsburgh, USA in 2003. The list of the previous Beauties:

Lodging

Standard (**) single/double rooms (with private bathroom) will be available within the **Cittadella** complex. This accommodation must be booked at Registration time using the form and has to be paid on arrival at the Registration Desk for the number of reserved nights. Arrival before June 19th or departure after June 24th are possible. The price for single rooms is 55€ per night, incl. breakfast, and is 40€ pp in double rooms.

A few higher level rooms have been pre-booked at the nearby (200 m) **Fontebella Hotel** (***) **Sup**) at special reduced rates. The rooms at Fontebella must be booked directly with the hotel quoting this **conference and using preferably the email: info@fontebella.com**

How to reach Assisi

The suggested solutions to reach Assisi **by air** are two:

- to land at Rome-Fiumicino Airport, and to continue to Assisi with bus or train or rented car; the rented car solution is recommended.
- to land at Milano-Malpensa Airport and connect to the **Alitalia** flight for Perugia (the small **Perugia-Umbria Airport**, also known as Sant'Egidio Airport, is only few kilometers from Assisi). You can save money, if you use Alitalia or one of the Skyteam associated airlines for your complete trip.

Conference registration and fees

Conference registration and fees payment will start on February 1st,2005. Please register electronically using the appropriate site page. If you are unable to register electronically, please contact our Conference Secretariat.

The conference fee for participants is Euro 250 for early registration and Euro 280 for late

registration. The deadline for early registration is **May 10th, 2005**

Payments can **only** be made by **money order** to the Beauty2005 bank account that will be indicated in the Registration form (all transfer costs paid at the source or charged on arrival). Payments on arrival can also be made with personal checks in €, but cashing costs must be added when checks are drawn on a foreign bank. Due to administrative and fiscal reasons we are not able to accept credit cards.
